Resolution

1. The IEM Alumni Association (“I AM IEM”) will be formed with an initial size of 40 members.
- 2.1. Permanent members shall consist of the former Students of IEM who have registered with IEM Alumni Association (“I AM IEM”). All the past and present faculty members of IEM, who are not an alumni of IEM would automatically be an Associate Member without any voting rights. Honorary Membership will be given to the person as an honour for the distinguished services contributed to the society/ profession. He or she can enjoy free lifetime membership.
- 3.1. Every member shall be entitled to enjoy the benefits in the Association, while discharging their duties in achieving the objectives of the Association.
- 3.2. The spouse and the minor children of the members are permitted to use the facilities of the Association without any rights.
- 3.3. A Member shall be liable for loss or damage that is caused to the property of the Association, either by him or by those accompanying him.
- 3.4. All Members would get a Registration Number and would have full access to the alumni brochure.
4. The following may be the reason for discontinuation or disqualifying a membership
 - i) Death

ii) Mental Instability

iii) Resignation

iv) Conviction

v) working against the interests and values of the Association

vi) directly or indirectly causing loss or damage to the Association or its property

The above dismissal cases can be recommended by the EC to the GB who may implement the same

5. The main functions of the Executive council must include:

i) Issuing circulars to convey meetings, regulate the affairs of the Association.

ii) Scrutinize and put up the annual budget to the General Body.

iii) Submit the annual report and the statement of accounts to the general body.

iv) Authorize General Secretary/ Treasurer of the Association to issue receipts for the amounts paid by the members of the Association.

v) The EC may authorize expenditure up to the approved budget amount decided in a General Body meeting.

vi) Major decisions on policy matters and/or decisions on issues involving conflict of interests of the group members shall be referred to the General Body.
