

Waste Oil Recycler, provides an innovative solution to recycle used engine oil into industry-grade fuel oil, particularly for maritime applications. The device includes a flameless chemical reaction chamber for controlled mixing of oil and chemicals, along with a high-speed centrifuge operating at 3000 RPM, which reduces sedimentation time by a factor of 1/48 compared to conventional methods.
